Dr Marg Stacey was happy to answer queries about her poster, PREVENT study: developing a dry mouth education program for GMPs.

For PREVENT study: evaluating acceptability of a GMP dry mouth intervention, Dr Denise Bailey was in attendance to answer any queries.


Mr Tan Nguyen answered questions about his poster, Revisiting the value of school dental check-up programs.
